We have in house digital radiography, blood machine, digital dental radiography, Tono-pen, 3 surgery suites and a dental suite. We treat dogs, cats and exotics pets with a Fear Free approach, individual consideration, and exemplary medicine.

The ideal candidate is enthusiastic about surgery, dentistry, community support, animal welfare and likes a fast-paced work environment with a lot of variety.
